For giving cash:

For giving securities:

Because these funds are administered under the financial umbrella of the San Francisco Foundation, gifts and bequests to our funds are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law. Please consult with your professional tax advisor for the IRS rules and regulations governing charitable gifts.
